Forbidden Foods

- Chocolate
- Xylitol (sugar substitute in baked goods, candies and peanut butters)
- Onions and garlic
- Raw dough
- Macadamia nuts

Dangerous Décor

- Never leave candles unattended
- Use electrical tape to secure cords
- Avoid tinsel which can cause obstructions
- Place a gate around the tree
- Avoid edible decorations and salt dough ornaments
- Make sure tree water is covered
- Quickly dispose of all wrapping materials

Party Time Precautions

- Use pheromone diffusers to help pets remain calm
- Use puzzle toys to keep pets occupied
- Set a room aside for your pets to be alone
- Educate your guests not to share food and to store medications in a safe place

Holly, mistletoe and poinsettias can make your pets sick. Lilies can be deadly to cats.

> Make sure your pet has a personalized ID tag and an up-to-date microchip.
